

# **Electronic Data Platform User Manual**

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# Disclaimer

Interconnector Limited (“INT”) makes use of browser cookies to identify your browser session and to enhance the user experience. These cookies are written to the user’s hard disk and read by server programs.

All actions performed within the Electronic Data Platform are logged and stored for monitoring and analysis purposes. This process may require that INT obtains and processes private data, which may be confidential.

By using the Electronic Data Platform, you acknowledge and agree that INT may process your private data in accordance with applicable data protection legislation. INT will only use the obtained personal data for the above internal purposes and will not disclose such data to any other third party unless required to do so by law or regulators.

INT will under no circumstances be liable for the use by any person of data obtained under the Electronic Data Platform.

# How to use the Electronic Data Platform

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## What is the Electronic Data Platform

The Electronic Data Platform is the open data application of INT, providing a number of data publications accessible for the public, and data publications solely accessible for individual INT customers.

### Regulation EC 715/2009

The European transmission system operators are bound to publish in a user friendly manner, information about the interconnection points on their internet website. INT has implemented a public and private data section on the Electronic Data Platform.

The Electronic Data Platform publishes aggregated supply and demand information about the INT interconnection points. This data is available to the public domain.

The Electronic Data Platform is also used to improve the communication between the shippers and INT, by publishing specific reports which are solely accessible by the registered users of the shipper.

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## System requirements


INT only supports the following configuration:

- Internet Explorer 8 or higher.
- JavaScript must be enabled.
- Cookies must be enabled.



# Transmission Section of the Electronic Data Platform

The Transmission section on the Electronic Data Platform describes access to the public and private data publications for INT as transmission system operator.

The public data publications are accessible without the need to sign in. The private data publications become available after the user has successfully signed in on the Electronic Data Platform (indicated by the symbol ).

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## INT Transportation System Capacities

This section provides data on the entry & exit capacities at the INT interconnection points. The following data publications are available:

- **Commercial available capacities:** the commercial maximum, contracted and available capacity per capacity category at the INT interconnection points.
- **Portfolio:** the capacities booked by your organisation at the INT interconnection points. This data publication is password protected.

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## Maintenance

The maintenance section describes the planned and unplanned works on the assets operated by INT, which might affect capacity availability. This information is publicly accessible.

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## Nominations

Shippers can use the nomination functions to create within day (intraday), day ahead or long term nominations. The following nomination functions are available:

- **Daily nominations:** create within day (intraday), day ahead or future date nominations per interconnection point.

Access to this application is restricted by password authentication.

- **Long term nomination:** create initial nominations per interconnection point for a longer period of time. Access to this application is restricted by password authentication.
- **Nominations and Flows:** The nominations and flows on interconnection points data publication provides the aggregated overview of nominations, allocations and physical flows on the INT Transportation System. This data is publicly accessible and can be downloaded in a number of formats (e.g. Microsoft Excel).

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## Allocations and Imbalances

Shippers can retrieve the provisional and validated hourly allocations for the interconnection points in real time from the Electronic Data Platform. This data publication is protected by password authentication.

Shippers can view their hourly imbalance position for a gas day.

The data can be downloaded in CSV or XML format.

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## Invoices

INT customers can retrieve invoices in this section. This data is protected by password authentication.

The following data publications are available:

- **PDF of invoice:** each invoice issued by INT can be downloaded. These invoices are available for a period of 13 months after invoicing date.
- **XML Invoice Appendix:** details describing the content of the invoice are available for download in structured XML format.

This section provides a link to the INT website where the INT Access Agreement, INT Access Code, INT Access Agreement Summary and INT Charging Statement can be found.

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## REMIT Messages

Regulation (EU) No. 1127/2011 on Wholesale Energy Market Integrity and Transparency or “REMIT” requires INT to disclose “inside information” publicly in an effective and timely manner.

The information which INT is required to publish under REMIT includes information about planned or unplanned unavailability at INT’s facilities, or any external event that adversely impacts capacity in INT’s Transportation System.
